- **Early Voting** is another excellent choice. Early voting allows you to vote in person before Election Day at designated locations throughout Lee County. It offers flexibility, shorter wait times, and the reassurance of casting your ballot in person while avoiding the Election Day rush.
- **Election Day Voting** remains an important option for voters who prefer the traditional experience of voting at their assigned precinct. If you choose this method, be sure to verify your polling location and allow enough time to vote.
