

Accepted forms of ID

Pursuant to Florida Law (s. 101.043 FS), you must present one of the following current and valid forms of Picture Identification before voting.

You will be asked to present a current and valid form of ID that includes a photograph and signature, or two separate forms which together contain this information. You can vote provisionally if you do not have proper ID with you. Your Picture ID must not be expired.

- Florida driver's license
- Retirement center identification
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- Neighborhood association identification
- United States passport
- Public assistance identification
- Debit or credit card
- Veteran Health Identification Card issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- Military identification
- License to carry a concealed weapon or firearm issued pursuant to s. 790.06; or an employee identification card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government, the state, a county, or a municipality (Section 101.043, F.S.)
- Student
